# Information about the Programme

The MPhil (Master of Philosophy) in Psychology of the University of Bolton is addressed to those who aim at furthering their knowledge through research in a specific field of psychology.

As a first stage to the MPhil programme, New York College offers a 'taught component', which constitutes a preparation phase with tutorials and workshops, conducted every second weekend of the month (Saturday and Sunday, 10am - 5.30pm). The taught component aims at refreshing students' research skills and assisting them in preparing their MPhil application, proposal and –ultimately– dissertation. The programme is conducted in English and it starts in November.<sup>1</sup> Students have access to NYC resources and e-library resources of the University of Bolton. After the 13th weekend of group supervision / teaching / workshops, each student arranges independent one-to-one meetings with their supervisor until the completion of their course of study.

Students can do their dissertation either on **Cognitive Psychology** or on **Sports Psychology**.

Eligibility criteria involve

(a) BSc or BA in Psychology with a grade equivalent to upper second class honours (i.e.  $\geq 60\%$ , or a GPA  $\geq 3$ , or a  $\geq 6.5$  grade from a Greek university) or BSc or BA in a related social science provided that it is accompanied by an MSc or MA in Psychology, and

(b) Proficiency in the English language (i.e. Cambridge Proficiency, or IELTS  $\geq 6.5$  or equivalent)

<sup>1</sup> Provided that there is an adequate number of students per class.
