
VISITING GREECE

Greece, a member of the European Union since 1981, is a country of enormous contrast and variety, situated on the southern part of the Balkan Peninsula. It combines high mountain ranges with a wide coastline of crystal clear waters and unspoiled beaches. It is the place where one of the oldest civilizations was born, the legacy of which can still be seen in the numerous monuments throughout the country. Over recent years, Greece has developed into a rapidly expanding center of maritime, commerce, light industry and high technology.

Athens, the capital city of Greece, is a place with a very strong presence of memories of the past, preserving a remarkable sense of historical continuity. The Acropolis, the marvel of the “Golden Age” of Pericles, when the Ancient Athenian Wonder was achieved, stands on a visible rock surrounded by the old neighborhood of Plaka - the oldest and most picturesque part of Athens; narrow streets and lanes, neoclassical houses, traditional handicraft shops and many restaurants.


